

Downloading Free Adobe E-PUB eBooks for your Nook HD, Nook HD+, Nook Color or Nook Tablet

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You will need:

- Your library account number
- Your pin number (usually the last four digits of your phone number or mother's maiden name in all lowercase letters)
- Your device

How to Download the Overdrive Media Console App for your Nook

- 1) From the home screen of your device, go to the **Shop** (you will be prompted to connect to a wireless internet connection at this time if you are not already connected).
- 2) Do a search for **Overdrive**.
- 3) Select the **Overdrive Media Console App**, then **Install**. This app will now install on your home screen.

Configuring the Overdrive Media Console App

- 1) After the Overdrive App has installed, go back to your home screen. Select the **Overdrive App**.
- 2) Select the **Settings** icon (on the Nook HD, this looks like three dots in the top right hand corner; for other Nook devices, this looks like three horizontal lines that can be in the top right hand corner or on the bottom of the screen).
- 3) This will pull up a menu. From that menu, click on **App Settings**.
- 4) Enter your Adobe ID and password, if you have one. If not, click on **Get a Free Adobe ID**. You will be directed to the Adobe website during this process. Create an Adobe ID and password. Go back to your **home screen** when you are finished.
- 5) Open the **Overdrive App** again, reselect **Settings**, then **App Settings**, and finally, press **Authorize**. **Enter the Adobe ID and password**, and then press **Authorize**. Click on the keyboard symbol near the bottom of the screen (this hides the keyboard) and then press the back button to take you back to the **Overdrive Bookshelf**.
- 6) Select the **Get Book** icon (this sometimes looks like a book with a plus sign in the right hand corner, and is an option available when selecting **App Settings**).

- 7) Select **Add a Library +**. Type in **Mid-Wisconsin Library, Wisconsin, United States**. Select the **Star** next to **WiLS (Wisconsin Public Library Cons...)**. The star must be filled in for your device to remember our library and so you do not have to re-select it every time you search for eBooks.

Checking Out eBooks for your Nook using the Overdrive Media Console App

- 1) Open the **Overdrive App** (if you have not already opened it). Tap to select the **Wisconsin Public Library Consortium**. This directs you to the Overdrive website.
- 2) **Sign into Overdrive**: Select **Sign In** (in the right hand corner of the Overdrive website). Select **West Bend Community Memorial Library** from the list of libraries. Enter your **library card number** (no spaces) and **PIN** (usually the last four digits of your phone number or your mother's maiden name), and click **Sign In**. Call us if you don't know your PIN at 262-335-5152.
- 3) Browse to find an eBook that you would like to check out—click on the **Menu Icon** (looks like three parallel horizontal lines), then select a category under eBooks that you would like to view. To browse only currently available titles, select the drop down menu that says **Show Me** on the left hand side of the page and select **Only Titles with Copies Available**.
- 4) Once you find a title that you want to check out, click on **Borrow**, or **Place a Hold**. If you selected **Place a Hold**, please read step 5. If you selected **Borrow**, skip forward to step 6.

***Be sure to check that the EPUB eBook format is listed as an available format for the title you are interested in, otherwise, you will not be able to proceed.**

***To change the amount of time that an eBook will be loaned to you, select "Change" under the Borrow icon, then select 7, 14 or 21 days, and select "Done."**

- 5) After selecting **Place a Hold**, you will be prompted to enter your email address where you want to be emailed when your eBook is ready for you. Once you receive this email, you can select the link inside of the email on your Nook that will open the Overdrive App, in order to download your book. Click on the **Account Icon** (looks like a person), then click **Holds**. Locate the title and select **Borrow**.
- 6) Select **Download** for the title that you would like to check out. The title will then download onto your device. You will be able to access the title by selecting the **Settings** icon on your Nook, and selecting **Bookshelf**. Enjoy!

Your eBook will expire automatically—you do not have to worry about returning it! Expired titles will, however, remain on your bookshelf until you manually delete them.

Deleting books from your eReader

- 1) While in your **Bookshelf** in the **Overdrive App** (you can access this by selecting the **Settings** icon), select the plus sign next to the title.
- 2) Select **Return/Delete**.
