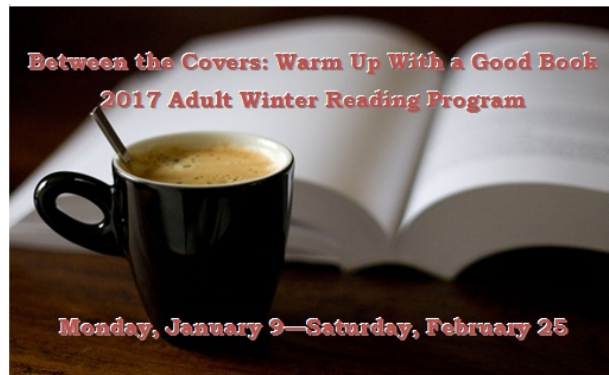

- All storytime sessions are drop-in and do not require advance registration. If you have questions, please contact Terika Koch at tkoch@west-bendlibrary.org.

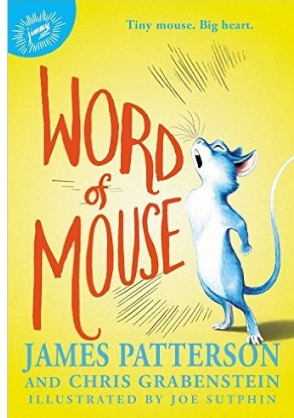


Library Book Clubs

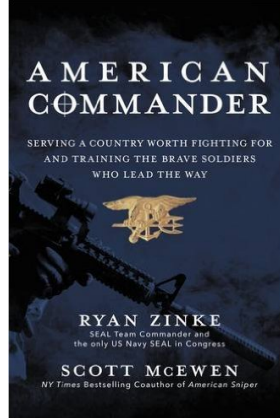

- **Book Bags** - Wednesday, January 25 @ 1 PM. Bring your own book for discussion!

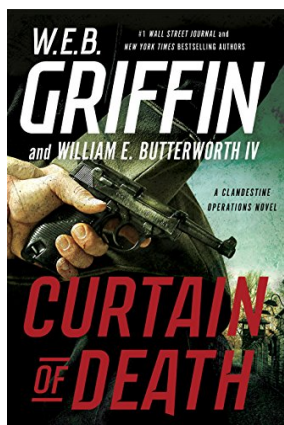
